Dear Parents:

It's hard to believe that the 2018-2019 school year is at its halfway point. 8th Grade Activities

Field Trip

The 8th grade team is placing the finishing touches on the much anticipated eighth grade field trip to Universal Studios and Islands of Adventure on **May 3, 2019**. The cost of this trip is **\$145**, and covers entrance to park, transportation, meal voucher and a GradVenture shirt. Students can bring money for additional food, beverages and souvenirs. Payment is due by **March 14th**. Please turn in money to Mrs. Borders in **Building 3 Room 212**. Checks must include name, address, phone number and driver's license number. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN FOR THE FIELD TRIP.** Additional details will be sent home once the field trip list is finalized.

Dance

The dance will take place at the Woman's Club in Dade City on **May 17th** from 6:30-8:30 pm. **ONLY 8TH GRADE PASCO MIDDLE STUDENTS ARE PERMITTED TO ATTEND THE DANCE.** Dress code is as follows: Boys are expected to wear long pants (no jeans) and a shirt with a collar. Girls are asked to wear a modest dress with straps. The cost of the dance is \$10. Tickets will go on sale May 6th.

Awards Ceremony

Families of our 8th grade students will be invited to a special awards ceremony in the auditorium on **5/29/2019**. This event is free of charge, and students will be asked to dress up for the occasion. There will be a morning and afternoon ceremony in order to accommodate students and guests. Students who have Mrs. Moran for their Language Arts teacher or Mrs. Johnson will participate in the morning ceremony. Students who have Ms. Day and Mrs. Borders for Language Arts will participate in the afternoon ceremony.

Eligibility

8th graders wishing to participate in end of the year activities must meet eligibility requirements. In order to be considered eligible, students must have a "D" or higher in all classes, and 1 or fewer Level 1 referrals. ***The administration of Pasco Middle School reserves the right to remove a student from an activity after the eligibility period if extenuating circumstances arise.*** The On-Track periods are as follows:

Dance: March 26th - May 3rd
