

PASCO MIDDLE SCHOOL DRESS CODE

The Dress Code as defined in the District School Board of Pasco County "Code of Student Conduct" will be in effect at all times. Pasco Middle students are to dress neatly and cleanly. All apparel is to be worn in an appropriate, modest fashion. If a student is found in violation, they will be asked to change into clothes provided by the school or parents may bring them appropriate clothing.

UNACCEPTABLE

ACCEPTABLE

SHIRTS

- Shirts, blouses and other tops cannot dip below a line formed between the right and left armpit. Shirts that are low-cut in the front, back, or sides are not permitted.
- Muscle shirts and tank tops are not permitted. Boys shirts must have sleeves. Girls may wear sleeveless shirts and the straps must wide enough to touch where the arm meets the shoulder, and must be a minimum of 3 inches wide.



PANTS

- The tops of pants, shorts and skirts must be worn at waist level; undergarments are not to be exposed.
- The bottoms of shorts and skirts must be no higher than four inches above the knee. Jeans with rips higher than four inches are not allowed.
- Slippers and pajama pants are not allowed.
- Clothing which displays pictures or sayings must be in good taste and not make any reference to weapons, drugs, illegal activities, violent behavior, alcohol or tobacco products. Any slogans that disrupt the learning environment are not permitted.
- Students are not permitted to bring hats, head-coverings of any other kind (**bandanas, do-rags, hoodies on head**), and chains are not allowed.
- Students may not wear a jacket to cover inappropriate clothing after they have been disciplined.



*Headphones are only to be used in the cafeteria and classrooms.
They are not to be worn in hallways.*
