Step 1: Log in or Create a myStudent Parent Portal

You can access your child's grades, view their schedule, monitor attendance, and pay fees by creating an account and ensuring your address and emergency contact information is up to date.

Activate your Parent Portal Account by selecting "Activate Account" on the screen. Enter the email address associated with your myStudent account and select "Send Email" which generates an email to activate the account. Go to your email and select the link. Continue by creating your password. Once this is completed, you will be able to see the school fees based on your student's courses and any other fees as needed
