WIRELESS COMMUNICATION DEVICE

WHEN ARE WIRELESS COMMUNICATION DEVICES PROHIBITED?

Pg. 16 of the Student Code of Conduct. Engaging in non-educational-related communications and/or usage during instructional time. Capturing, recording or transmitting the words or sounds, audio, images, pictures and/or video of any student, staff member or other person in the school or while attending a school-related activity without expressed prior notice and explicit written and/or verbal consent of said party and/or as indicated by a student's Individual Education Plan (IEP). Capturing and/or recording fights or similar events and/or subsequent posting of said recordings/images to social media and similar outlets. Distracting use/behavior that creates an unsafe environment. Taking pictures, recording video or any similar activity in locker rooms, shower facilities, and/or rest/bathrooms Capturing, recording and/or transmitting test information or any other information in a manner constituting fraud, theft, cheating, or academic dishonesty or using a WCD to receive such information. Using WCDs in any manner that otherwise violates the Student Code of Conduct

WHEN CAN I USE A WIRELESS COMMUNICATION DEVICE?

Before and after school, lunch, in between classes, after school activities, on the school bus, and when a classroom teacher allows you to use it for an instructional activity.

CAN A STAFF MEMBER CONFISCATE MY WIRELESS COMMUNICATION DEVICE?

Yes, refusing to hand over your WCD is defiance of authority. You will automatically receive a Discipline Referral.

WHAT ARE THE CONSEQUENCES FOR INAPPROPRIATE OR REPEATED USE OF A WCD?

- 1) Confiscation, student picks up
- 2) Confiscation, parent picks up
- 3) Confiscation, parent picks up & 3 days ISS lunch
- 4) Confiscation, parent picks up, 2 days After School Detention
- 5) Confiscation, parent picks up, Saturday Detention & PTC
- 6) Confiscation, parent picks up, Discipline Referral & OSS
